 - God gives specific instructions to the man. (15-17)
 - 1. Eat of every tree?
 - 2. An exception?
- e. Creation of woman and the first family. (18-25)
 - See 1:27.
 - Not good for man to be alone. (18)
 - Adam gives names to the "living creatures". (19-20)
 - No helper found for man. (20)
 - Adam falls asleep? (21-22)
 - 1. Woman created from one of Adam's ribs.
 - 2. Woman is brought unto Adam.
 - Adam (ish) calls his "help meet" woman (isha) because she was "taken out of man". (23)
 - 1. I Corinthians 11:8—"For the man is not of the woman; but the woman of the man".
 - Man and Woman were and are to be "one flesh". (24)
 - 1. What is said in this verse has meaning for all people and all times.
 - 2. See Matthew 19:3-9 where Jesus quotes from this verse and speaks of the sanctity of marriage.
 - Sin had not entered into the world at this time. (25)
