 - 1. Listens to Satan.
 - 2. Should have denounced Satan.

 - 1. "Ye shall not surely die."
 - 2. You will be as "gods".

 - 1. She saw, she took, she ate (and shared with Adam).

- i. Walking in the Garden. (8)

 - 1. "Where art thou?" (9)
 - 2. We are hiding! (10)
 - 3. Questions from God, "buck passing" from Adam and the "blame-game" by Eve. 11-13)

c. A curse placed upon the serpent. (14-16)

- i. Forced to crawl on his belly. (14)
- ii. Alienated from man. (15)
- iii. "Veiled" promise of Jesus Christ, the "seed of woman".(15)
- iv. Woman's sorrow multiplied. (16)

d. A curse placed upon the ground. (17-21)

- e. Adam & Eve are driven from the Garden of Eden. (1727) (22-24)
 - i. They no longer have the same relationship with God, walking with Him in the perfect surroundings of their perfect home: they are separated from Him. (This is spiritual death.)
 - ii. Separated from the "Tree of Life", they will now experience physical death.
