 - iii. Evil to be refrained from would include:
 - 1 Slander—Proverbs 10:18.
 - 2. Lying—Ephesians 4:25.
 - 3. Deceit-Psalm 120:2.
 - 4. Filthy language—Ephesians 4:29.
 - 5. Failure to control tongue—James 3:1-12.

b. Exhorted to doing and living righteously. (11)

- i. Move away from evil and do good. (11a)
 - 1. Jesus "went about doing good". (Acts 10:38)
 - 2. Be "zealous of good works". (Titus 2:14
- ii. Look for and pursue peace. (11b)
 - 1. Matthew 5:9—"Blessed are the peacemakers..."

III. REASONS GIVEN FOR FOLLOWING PETER'S (GOD'S) ADVICE. (12)

- a. The eyes of the Lord—over the righteous.
- b. The ears of the Lord—open to the prayers of the righteous.
